Hound Parish Council proposed road names that have been approved on the new housing estates at Kestrel Park, Kingfisher Grange and Monarch's Keep, Hamble Lane.

JACOBS - WW1 - lived at The Plough
Old Netley
KNOWLTON - awarded the Albert Medal for bravery lived on Hamble Lane, Old Netley
LANGTRY - Phoebe Langtry - 1st lady miller/ owner of Bursledon Windmill (which was then in Hound)
LEIGH - Farmer, Old Netley Farm
NEWMAN - WW1 - lived in Rose Cottage, Old Netley
NORTON - awarded the DSM for bravery lived on Hamble Lane, Old Netley.
TOWERS View - Bursledon Towers was the name of large country house which was on the site now occupied by Tesco
WARWICK - Farmer, Old Netley
VOSPER - brothers Arthur and Charles - both died during WW1 - one in Belgium, the other in Mesopotamia both from Green Lane, Old Netley
BOWERS, LE MARECHAL, HOLLOWBREAD - Names of former Hound Parish Councillors
LUCK, RENOLDSON, ROSIER, STRIDE - Names have been selected from the Old Netley War Memorial all lived in Netley Abbey, Butlocks Heath, Hamble and Bursledon.
